



Progress Report: May 7, 2021

We share this report with deep gratitude for your financial support to address COVID-19's ongoing health impact across India. Because of you, we have been able to make good progress in our 'Curb the Surge Campaign' to save lives. Thank you!

There are several ways in which WISH is providing critical pandemic relief across India, including:

- Supply of medical equipment, amenities, including oxygen concentrators and cylinders, human resources to the public and private hospitals operating COVID-Care Centers (CCCs) for patients
- Set up oxygen plants in Delhi and Chennai
- Overall operation and management of CCCs as requested by state governments or charitable hospitals, through end-to-end support
- Setting up CCCs in buildings like schools, hotels, community centers, etc. based on space identified by corporate and other funders and allotted by government authorities
- Setting up COVID Care step-down models within the hospital periphery and other facilities.
- Vaccination-Drive support to the government, as WISH's healthcare workers, are vaccinating the local
 population at the 700 plus primary health centers in Delhi and Rajasthan, which we manage and operate.
 Since January this year, we are also continuing to run awareness-building campaigns with promotional
 materials, community mobilization efforts, and capacity-building sessions across various states.

We are optimally utilizing available government resources in COVID-Care Centers (CCCs) wherever available, and supplementing them with amenities such as oxygen, isolation wards, proper nutrition, and regular vital checks that are usually missing in most of the current facilities. Our state-wise efforts include:

- Delhi-NCR: We've distributed life-saving oxygen concentrators and PPE equipment to Holy Family Charitable Hospital and have set up a CCC. We're providing life-saving equipment and oxygen plants in several leading hospitals, including Devki Devi Charitable Max Hospital, Saket; Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Government Hospital, and one in Rohini. This is in addition to our ongoing primary healthcare services across the Mohalla Clinics and vaccination program in the designated centers. In Gurgaon, the CCC is in progress in Badshahpur with a 20-30 bedded facility, within the space provided by the Haryana Government. We are also mobilizing Self-Help-Groups (SHGs) and equipping them with oxygen tanks, thermometers, oximeters, PPE kits, etc., and training them on sanitization and patient-care protocols.
- **Madhya Pradesh:** On May 6th we launched the first of the two 20 and 30-bedded CCCs in Bhopal, with the second one due in Jabalpur. We are running these CCCs with one human resource and related costs contributed by the state government. We're also providing piped oxygen facility to the MP Police Department's CCCs, in addition to mental health services and Yoga across the state.
- Rajasthan: Were setting up two CCCs in Alwar; and one each in rural areas of Sawai Madhopur, Dungarpur, Rajsamand, Baran, and Jaipur/urban. This is in addition to our ongoing primary healthcare services within the rural and urban primary health centers, along with COVID-vaccination of the local population.
- * Uttar Pradesh: We are setting up CCCs in Noida, Lucknow, and Hardoi.
- ** Assam: We are providing oxygen concentrators, PPE kits, and other medical equipment to National Health Mission-Assam for select hospitals. Tele-consultations are being provided under the government's "Sampark" initiative. We plan to set up a 200 bed CCC in Guwahati, and additional CCCs in about 15 Tea Garden hospitals.
- **Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu:** We've established a partnership with Nanavati hospital in Mumbai, and the Vijaya Group of Hospitals in Chennai for the provision of life-saving medical supplies, etc.

In addition, capacity-building of health workers on COVID-management, home-isolation, sanitation practices, COVID-vaccine promotion, etc. has been ongoing since last year through our virtual Wish2Learn self-guided and simulated learning platform. **Teleconsultations** via **eSanjeevani** for handling COVID-19 cases have been ongoing, with over 1.10 million consultations already delivered.
